### Extra! Extra! Read All About It!

Dear Mission Hill School Friends, Families, Students, and Staff,



In many ways the Mission Hill School weekly newsletter is like the heartbeat of our school. Since we opened our doors in the fall of 1997, we have sent home a newsletter at the end of each week. Reading the newsletter is one of the best ways to be engaged with school, and sharing this experience with your child is even better.

Through reading the newsletter, you will be able to watch the learning unfold in your own child's classroom and in other classrooms as well. You'll stay current about what is happening in the school and what is coming down the road. I encourage you to have conversations with your children about what you've read in the newsletter. For example, "Tell me more about when your class...?"; "What are your ideas about...?"; "How do you feel about...?" etc. These types of questions will deepen your connection to your child's experience at school, as

well as encourage language development and higher-order thinking. I am asking you to commit to reading the newsletter weekly, and I am committed to making sure our classroom columns are there for you every week.

The front page of every newsletter is a message to our entire community. Although it is often written by our school leaders and can be written by anyone: students, staff, or families. If you or your child has an idea for a front page, feel free to call me at 617-635-6384 or email me at gmclaughlin@missionhillschool.org with the word "Newsletter" in your subject line.

This is the second week we are sending home paper copies of our newsletter. Let me know if you didn't receive the newsletter we sent home last Friday. We have extra copies in the main office. Starting

Friday 9/20/19, we will be emailing the newsletter as a way to save paper. Also starting next week you will be able to read all the classroom columns. (So far this year, classrooms have been communicating directly with the families in only their own classroom.) If you prefer to continue receiving a paper copy please call the office at 617-635-6384.
